- Creation of a methodological approach for future concrete and harmonised actions

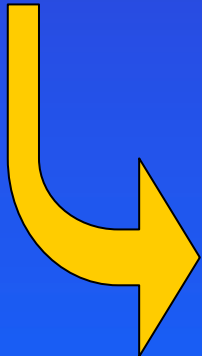

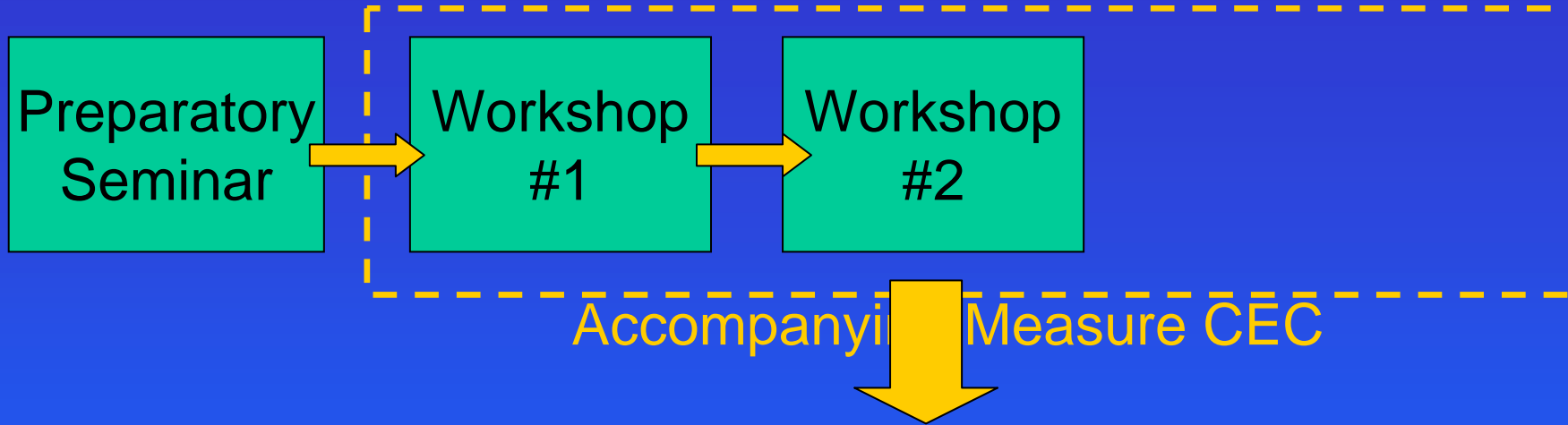

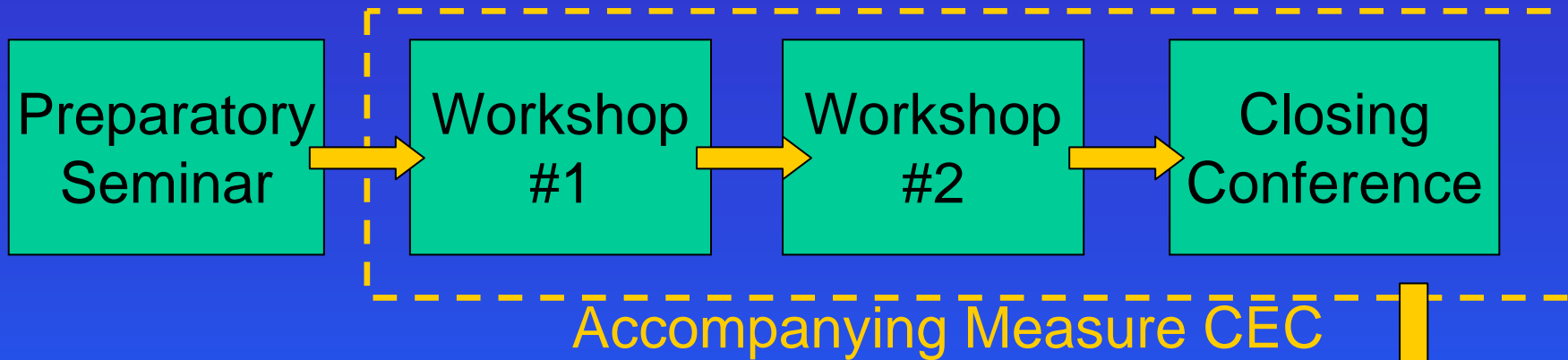
