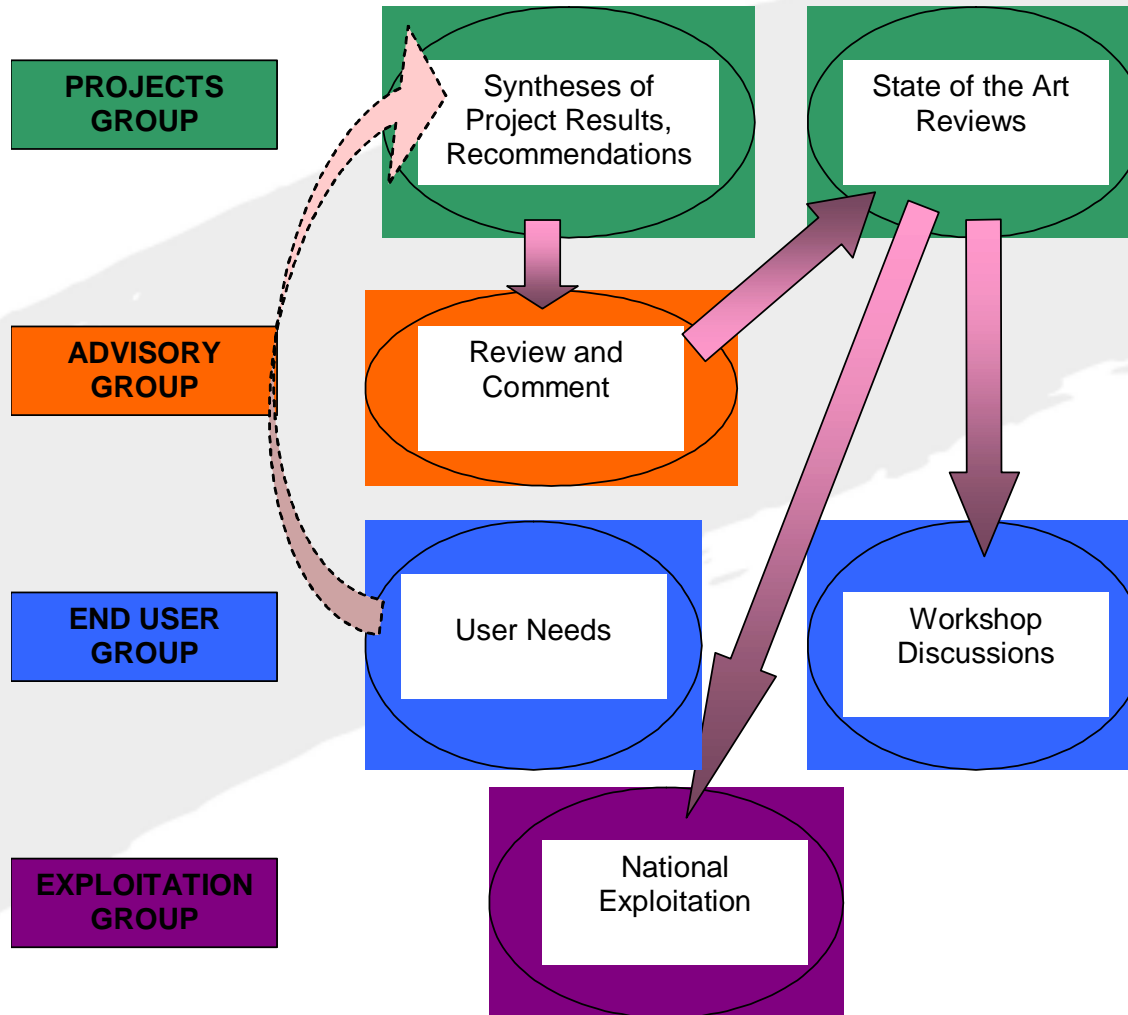
Objective
