European Transport Policy

- Transport basis for functioning of the internal market
 - ► free movement of people and goods
- Transport closely linked to other EU policies
 - ► growth and employment, social cohesion, energy, environment and sustainable development,
- Urban transport integral part of European transport
 - ▶ urban areas origin and destination of main transport flows
- European policy measures impact on urban mobility
 - ► Trans-European Networks-Transport; Legislation on air quality, noise mapping, pollutant emissions; alternative fuels, public procurement...

 - ► Importance of cities with regard to key EU policies: Climate and environment; security of energy supply Growth and employment; competiveness of EU economy
- 2006: Mid-term review White Paper
 - ► Announcement: Green Paper on urban mobility
- 2007: Green Paper on urban mobility
 - ► Added value of Community action
- 2009: New urban mobility actions
 - **▶** towards an Action Plan

➤ Three phases funded by the EU R&D Framework Programme CIVITAS I: 2002 – 2006 (FP 5)
CIVITAS II: 2005 – 2009 (FP 6)
CIVITAS +: 2008 – 2012 (FP 7)

- Integrated approach
- ▶ 600 technical und policy-based measures in 58 cities
- ► € 180 Million EU contribution; € 360 Million total programme size

- 25 questions regarding measures and competencies
- Representative contributions from all parts of society;
 Opinions of the EU Institutions
- Preparation of an Action Plan based on consultation
- Launch of new urban mobility actions in 2009
