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## Rationale for cooperation

### Interdependence

- Vehicle fleets
- Common customers
- Common interest
- Understanding disagreements

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## FREDERIC I

- Freight Delivery Rationalisation in Cities
- EU-funded
- Consortium – cities, manufacturers, deliverers
- Consensus building- Common understanding, common issues
- Something special

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## FREDERIC II

- Two successful workshops (Paris/London) Identifying and developing common issues.
- Final conference early 2004.
- Platform for future collaboration.
- Freight may be easier to develop consensus.

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## Passengers

- More complex
- More confrontational
- Having made progress on freight may now be the time to consider passenger transport.

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## Cooperation

- Yes – good reasons for doing it.
- Beginning to develop some consensus.
- Some progress on freight issues.
- May need to start work on passenger issues.
